

WEDDING CEREMONY PLANNING & RESERVATION FORM

Thank you for your interest in a wedding ceremony at St. Chrysostom's Episcopal Church. At St. Chrysostom's Church, the celebration and blessing of a marriage is a sacred occasion. St. Chrysostom's takes seriously the responsibility of upholding those who enter the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony. Members of the St. Chrysostom's congregation can be married here. It is expected that members support the church through a financial pledge. It is our wish that you might see St. Chrysostom's as your church home, a place to worship and be fed, a place to seek God and each other as you begin your life together.

I. Ceremony Guidelines

Weddings at St. Chrysostom's are conducted according to the order of service found in <u>The Book of Common Prayer under Pastoral Offices</u>, starting on page 423. This is your primary tool in planning a wedding service.

The officiating clergy, under the direction of the Rector of St. Chrysostom's, is in charge of all aspects of the wedding. This individual also conducts the wedding rehearsal and usually pre-marital counseling as well. Other Episcopal or ecumenical clergy in good standing are welcome to assist. As marriage is a sacramental rite, the clergy are in charge of all aspects of the ceremony.

MUSIC

Because the wedding service is an act of worship, wedding music at St. Chrysostom's is ruled by the Episcopal Canon Law and the policies of this parish. Only sacred music is allowed during the service: any sacred music deemed appropriate for all services in this church having an approved text (Prayer Book, Bible, Hymnal) is suitable for your ceremony.

The Director of Music will assist you in choosing appropriate music as well as any special music you wish. All guest musicians must meet with and be approved by the Director of Music. Please see the <u>Ceremony Music Section</u>.

PRE-MARITAL COUNSELING

The Canons of the Episcopal Church require couples to attend three (3) or more pre-marital counseling sessions with the clergy in preparation for marriage. Please arrange to meet with the clergy, preferably the one officiating your wedding, as the first step in your marriage preparation. Sessions with the clergy will entail everything from planning portions of the service to discussions regarding your life together as partners in money, parenting, etc. Both parties are responsible for reading the marriage rite in The Book of Common Prayer.

These sessions do not include any meetings with the Music Director or church staff for coordinating ceremony activities. You are encouraged to meet with them separately to make sure the needs and arrangements for your specific day are addressed and we can make it as wonderful as you wish.

MARRIAGE LICENSE

A marriage license should be obtained from the County Courthouse not more than 20 days prior to the ceremony. This document must be presented to the officiating clergy or church staff at the wedding rehearsal. This will be completed and sent back to the County Clerk's Office by the Parish office.

PHOTOGRAPHS

- May be taken before or after the service in the church and/or courtyard.
- During the ceremony, the photographer will remain behind the congregation until the final recession is complete.
- The photographer may take flash photos during the seating of relatives, procession, and after the final blessing.
- Flash photography is not allowed during the ceremony.
- Provided that they remain behind all seated guests, photographers may take pictures using existing lighting during the ceremony.
- Clergy will interrupt the service if necessary, to address any infractions of the set rules.
- Any variations must be approved by the officiating clergy prior to the ceremony.

VIDEOTAPING

- The camera must remain stationary in the Crane Chapel.
- No artificial lighting may be used.
- The clergy must approve all video plans.

WEDDING PROGRAMS

• The production of the wedding program is the responsibility of the couple being married. The clergy must approve before printing.

DECORATIONS

- Flowers: We request that flowers be left to beautify Sunday worship in your honor.
- Candles: The church will provide candles for the altar. We also have a set of 14 wooden candelabra for the aisle available for rent. Decorating the candelabra is not permitted, because it presents a fire hazard. No other candles may be used.
- Pew decorations: It is permitted to decorate the pews as long as nothing is attached with tape of any kind, as this pulls the finish off the wood. Ribbon is recommended for these purposes.
- Aisle runners: Aisle runners are a trip hazard and therefore, are not allowed.
- Throwing rice, birdseed, confetti, etc., either in the church or in the courtyard, is prohibited. Flower petals are permitted but it is the responsibility of the wedding party to see that they are cleaned up afterward.
- Plans for other decorations should be discussed with church staff.

PARKING

There are several garages nearby for parking and city parking rules apply. Parking suggestions: street parking, valet at RH Chicago (1300 N. Dearborn) and garages (88 W. Schiller & 1250 N. Dearborn).

There's a drop off with ramp in front of the church then a ramp that will take you into the church to access the sanctuary.

FEES

Please refer to the <u>Contract Section</u> with all relevant fees. All fees must be paid two weeks prior to the ceremony date. Payments can be mailed to the church office or paid online: https://onrealm.org/SaintC/give/ceremony.

III. Ceremony Music

Richard Hoskins, Director of Music is delighted to help you shape the music for your ceremony. The spectacular Fisk organ, various soloists, trumpeters and the carillon are all available for your celebration service. The information sheet contains the song titles by the song numbers listed in the music table below.

Wedding music at St. Chrysostom is ruled by Canon Law and the church policies. Only sacred music is allowed during the service: any sacred music deemed appropriate for services in the church having an approved text (selected from the Book of Common Prayer, the Bible, the Hymnal) is suitable. Recorded music of any kind is not allowed. We welcome guest musicians, but the choice of music must be pre-approved.

The standard program of music includes a 20-minute prelude chosen by the organist, a Processional and a Recessional. You are encouraged to add hymns sung by family and friends, plus 1 or 2 solos sung by a member of our Choir or choral anthems sung by our Choir. Specific requests for organ music and other music may also be included.

The Music Information Sheet includes many specific Processional and Recessional pieces from which to choose. All may be played by trumpet except those by Pachelbel, Bach and Widor. The works by Purcell, Clarke, Charpentier, Handel and Mouret can be used for both Processional and Recessional.
