The Chiapas Project is a joint, lay effort by four churches to offer food support for 45 families facing food insecurity in the barrio of the Anglican church of San Benito de Nursia in San Christobal, Chiapas. Two times each month the congregation at San Benito holds a food pantry that packages groceries for several days of beans, rice, oil and sugar for the families; in return the recipients have their pictures taken so that their brothers and sisters in Chicago can be assured that their money was, indeed, used to purchase much-needed food. About one-third of the recipients are not members of the church; we celebrated the five year anniversary of the project last November.



The church at San Benito has recently been engaged in a crochet and embroidery project to raise funds to replace timbers in the church roof; some of their work has been used this month to brighten up the newsletter.
